



Recycle Alcona County

Welcome to the world of Recycle Alcona County (RAC)! If you have received this flyer, then you are either already recycling and doing your part for our environment, or someone cared enough for our environment to get you started in recycling. First some information about our organization:

- ✓ Recycle Alcona County was formed in the spring of 1992.
- ✓ It is completely made up of volunteers.
- ✓ We are a non-profit organization created for the citizens of Alcona County.
- ✓ RAC currently collects an average of 6 tons of recyclable material per month.

Our drop off days are held at the Alcona Recreation Area (ARA Site) in Lincoln every second Saturday of each month. The hours for the drop off are from 10:00 AM to 1:00 PM. A ~~5.00~~ ^{55.00} minimum donation is required at the gate.



LIST OF ACCEPTED RECYCLABLE ITEMS



CARDBOARD:



☛ **Corrugated:** Non wax coated with wavy corrugation in the middle. Please remove any plastic wrap or packaging. Boxes **MUST** be flattened, cut or folded and in a manageable bundle or stack.



☛ **Boxboard:** Cereal boxes, tissue boxes, shoe boxes and nearly any box from your pantry are accepted. Please remove any plastic inner bags or windows. Flatten boxes and stuff into either a large box (e.g. cereal box) or pack tightly into a brown paper bag.

We do NOT accept: Pizza boxes, Frozen food boxes, Waxy cartons (e.g. Orange Juice or Rice Milk cartons)

PAPER:



☛ **NEWSPAPER:** Newspapers AND glossy inserts accepted. No need to separate! Bundle or place in brown paper bags.



☛ **MIXED OFFICE PAPER/JUNK MAIL:** White office paper, colored paper, computer paper, notebook paper, junk mail, envelopes (windows okay), manila folders, yellow pad paper, NCR or carbonless forms, sticky notes and paperback books are accepted. Paper items and **SHREDDED** paper **MUST** be in clear plastic bags.



☛ **MAGAZINES/CATALOGS AND PHONE BOOKS:** Magazines and catalogs accepted. Please bundle them with rubber bands or twine. You can also place them in a brown paper bag or corrugated box. Phone books can be loose. * **HARD COVERS OF BOOKS MUST BE REMOVED** * **INSIDE PAGES ARE ACCEPTABLE** *

STYROFOAM: **MUST BE SEPARATED!** Accept all kinds of Styrofoam. Egg carton, packaging peanuts, packaging forms, etc. Must be placed in clear plastic bag and must be sealed to prevent Styrofoam from blowing away.

PLASTIC CONTAINERS: All #1 thru #7 plastic containers. Remove caps and throw in garbage. Containers **MUST** be rinsed.

We do NOT accept the following:

- Bubble Wrap or Air Packaging Pillows
- Automotive fluid containers
- NO Plastic bags of ANY number.

ALUMINUM & TIN: Steel, tin and aluminum cans. Empty, capless aerosol cans (leave nozzle on). Clean aluminum foil and food trays. Aluminum and Tin **MUST** be rinsed. Labels are okay.



We do NOT accept:

- Scrap or other metals not listed above.

GLASS BOTTLES AND JARS: All clear, brown and green glass bottles and jars. Remove lids and throw in garbage. Glass **MUST** be rinsed.

We do NOT accept the following:

- Drinking glasses
- Light bulbs
- Mirrors
- Window glass
- Ceramics
- Dishes or cookware
